







1. What are the 3 main qualifications for becoming a member of the FMETU Executive Committee?




2. What are the 3 main qualifications for FMETU international coordinator?






4. What are the 3 most important areas that you feel are necessary for training?




5. What is the percentage of women that should be on the executive committee?








